António M. Cunha and Carlos Bernardo elected for the Academy of Engineering

Professor António M. Cunha, Full Professor and Rector of the UMinho, and Professor Carlos Bernardo, Emeritus Professor, both from the Department of Polymer Engineering (DEP) of the EEUM, were elected as Members of the Academy of Engineering. The official welcoming ceremony for the new members will take place on the 19th December, in Lisbon, during the commemoration of the Academy of Engineering Day.

Founded in 1995, the Academy of Engineering aims at contributing to the valorisation of Engineering in Society and encouraging the development of research in technical and scientific areas of Engineering. The Society aims also at promoting cooperation in engineering in Portugal, the European Union and other countries, as well as collaborating with the Portuguese Government and the Portuguese Board of Engineers in issues of national interest for Engineering, while contributing to the recognition and development of Engineering and the Engineer profession as a whole.

DEI adapts electronic toys for disabled children



As has been done in previous years, the Robotics Group of the Department of Industrial Electronics (DEI) of the EEUM adapted toys to be offered to children with disabilities this Christmas. This initiative counted on the cooperation of SALUSLIVE, therapeutic centre.

For three weeks, several second-hand electronic toys were received at the Laboratory of Automation and Robotics (in Guimarães). Moved by the Christmas spirit, students were in charge of adapting them in order to change the action mechanism. The adaptation, although relatively simple in most of the toys, can become quite difficult in case of more intricate electronic circuits. However, it is the only way to create a universal method so that all children are able to use them. The toys were then offered to several local institutions.
