Paulo Sampaio is Associate Professor at the Department of Production and Systems (DPS) of the EEUM since November 2011. He completed his bachelor degree in Industrial Management and Engineering in 2002 and his PhD in Production and Systems Engineering in 2008, both at the University of Minho. He is a doctorate researcher, as Integrated Member, at the Supply-chain, Logistics and Transportation Systems Group from the ALGORITMI Research Centre. From February to August 2015 he was Visiting Scholar at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), in the framework of the MIT-Portugal Programme, where he stayed on sabbatical leave. Paulo Sampaio develops his activity as professor and researcher in the areas of Quality and Organisational Excellence. He started his career as professor at the UMinho, in September 2000, as Monitor at the Department of Production and Systems. He was a member of the Portuguese Association for Certification (APCER) as Product and Project Manager, from January 2003 to September 2004. From October 2004 to October 2008 he was a PhD research fellow of the Portuguese Foundation for Science and Technology. Between January 2009 and November 2011 he was Invited Professor, equivalent to Assistant Professor, at the Department of Production and Systems.

Paulo Sampaio is currently a member of the Steering Committee of the Master Programme in Engineering and Quality Management of the UMinho, since 2013. He is a member of the School Council of the School of Engineering of the University of Minho since 2013. He coordinates the Working Group ALGORITMI Business Excellence since 2013. Country Counsellor of the American Society for Quality (ASQ) for Portugal, since 2010. Member of the Technical Standardisation Committee 80 - Quality Management and Quality Assurance, of the Portuguese Institute for Quality, representing UMinho, since 2011. Member of the ASQ Influential Voices group, since 2012. Member of ASQ's Feigenbaum Medal Committee, since 2013. Member of ASQ's Global Advisory Board, since 2014. Member of the Certification Forum of the Portuguese Institute for Quality, since 2015. In 2006 he was granted a Best Paper Award at the Student Technical Paper Competition, organised in the framework of the American Society for Quality World Conference on Quality and Improvement. In 2008, his PhD thesis was distinguished by the Portuguese Quality Association as the Best Research Work on Quality. In June 2009, he was granted the category of Senior Member by the American Society for Quality. In November 2011, he was recognised by the American Society for Quality as one of the "40 New Voices of Quality" worldwide. In 2012 he was awarded with the Feigenbaum Medal by the American Society for Quality. In 2014 he was admitted as Associate Member of the International Academy for Quality. In 2015 he was considered as part of the Group of Best Reviewers of the Total Quality Management and Business Excellence Journal (2010-2014). He is Vice-Dean of the School of Engineering of the University of Minho since September 2016.
